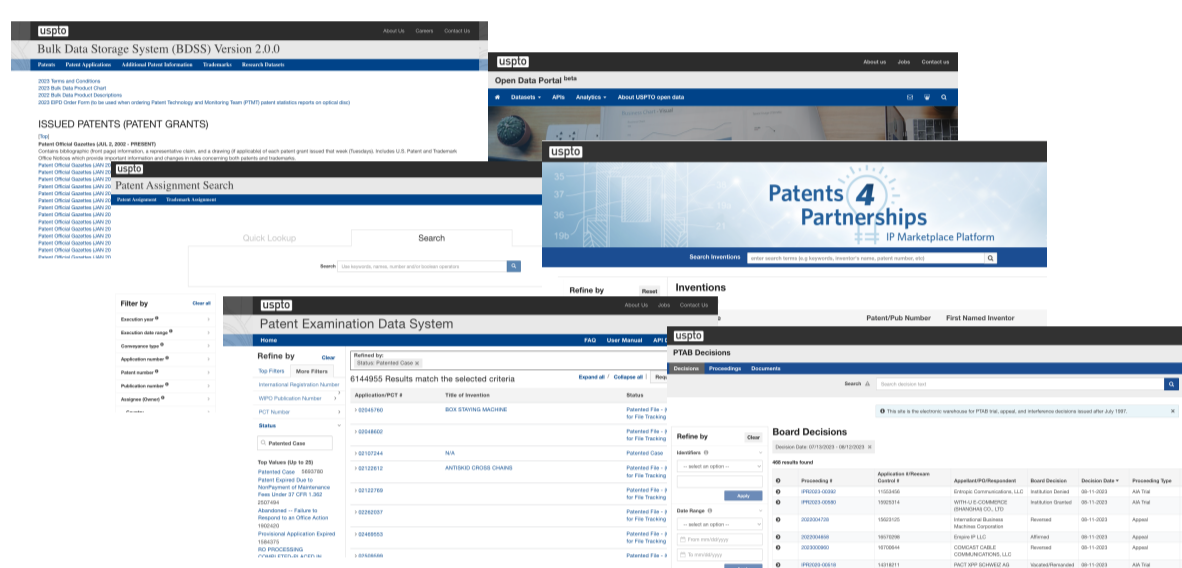

THE VISION

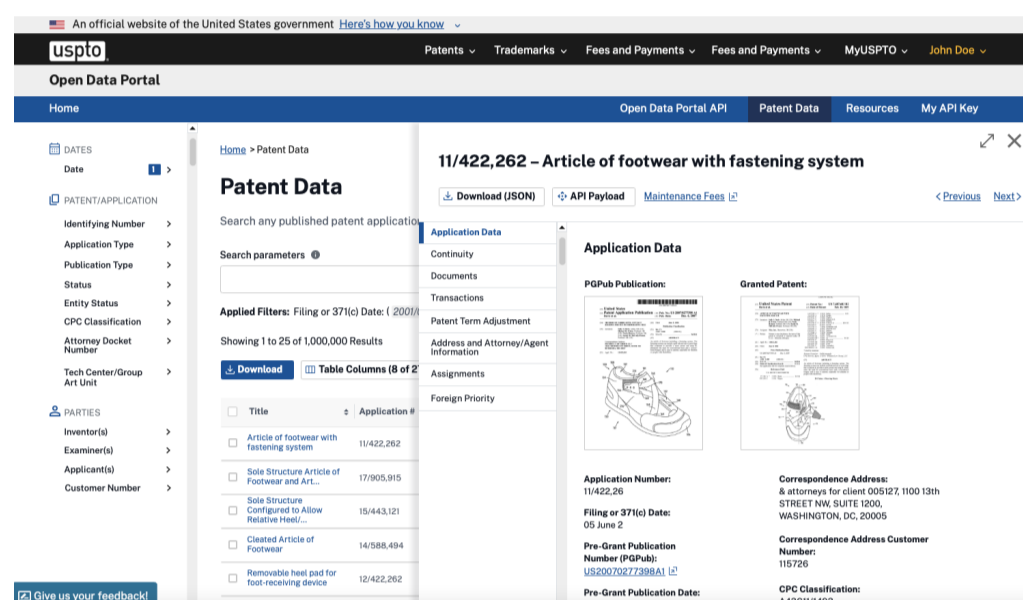
The new **Open Data Portal (ODP)** is the evolution of open data at the USPTO: a unified platform offering you public patent and trademark data all in one place. ODP will fold several data dissemination services into one central website that empowers you to rapidly discover and easily extract USPTO data in the way that you want. Built using your insights, the user-friendly interface offers a new, seamless experience that will include your feedback in every iteration. Join us in unlocking a vibrant world of possibilities driven by data-informed innovation and creativity.



Currently, customers have to access multiple platforms or create workarounds to find needed data that isn't available in specific datasets - negatively impacting the user experience of extracting USPTO data.



With the new Open Data Portal, customers will be able to search USPTO data in one centralized platform and efficiently extract data in the way they want - be it large datasets or more specific attributes.

THE VOYAGE

Customer demand for USPTO data has grown rapidly since the launch of the original Open Data Portal initiative in 2015 - from 50 users to millions. The new Open Data Portal is the next step in the USPTO journey to amplify the public value, accessibility, and efficiency of patent and trademark data sharing. Improved Patent Examination Data System (PEDS) capabilities will be added to ODP in late 2023, followed by the Bulk Data Storage System (BDSS) and Developer Hub (Open Data Portal beta). Ultimately, Trademark Decisions and Proceedings will transition to ODP.

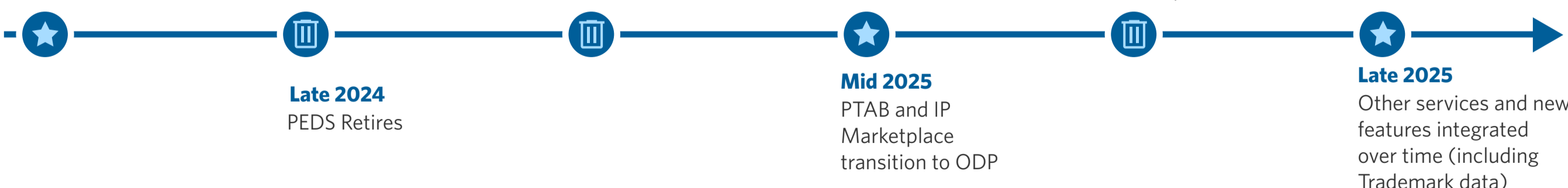
Notional Release Roadmap: This timeline is subject to change and is provided to help inform users of additional usability testing opportunities.
